Freire closely observed the education system and the society in Brazil and realized that the education system is helping the dominant groups to keep their authoritative position over the oppressed. Freire proposed the 'banking concept of education'.

Diagnose Paulo Freire's perspective on education

Freire insisted that the function of education was to build on the language, experiences and skills of the 'educatees', rather than imposing on them the culture of the 'educators'. Freire took education out of the classroom and created 'the culture circle', where learners used their own ways of speaking to articulate their shared understanding of how their world came to be like it was and how to act to change their future.
